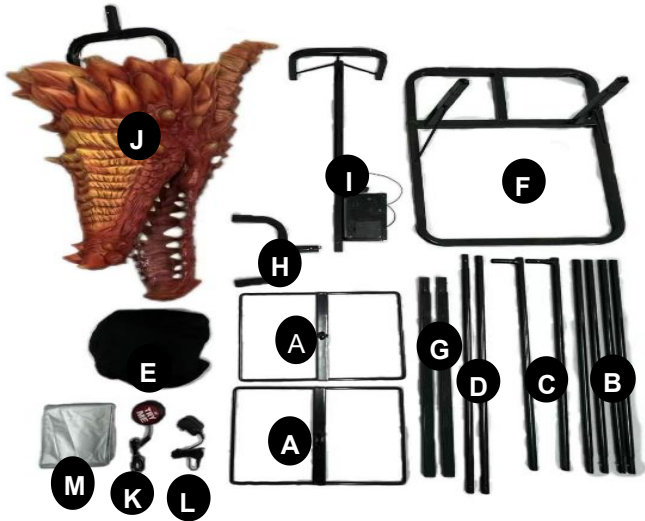
WARNING

Please read all instructions carefully before assembling. Save this instruction sheet for future reference.

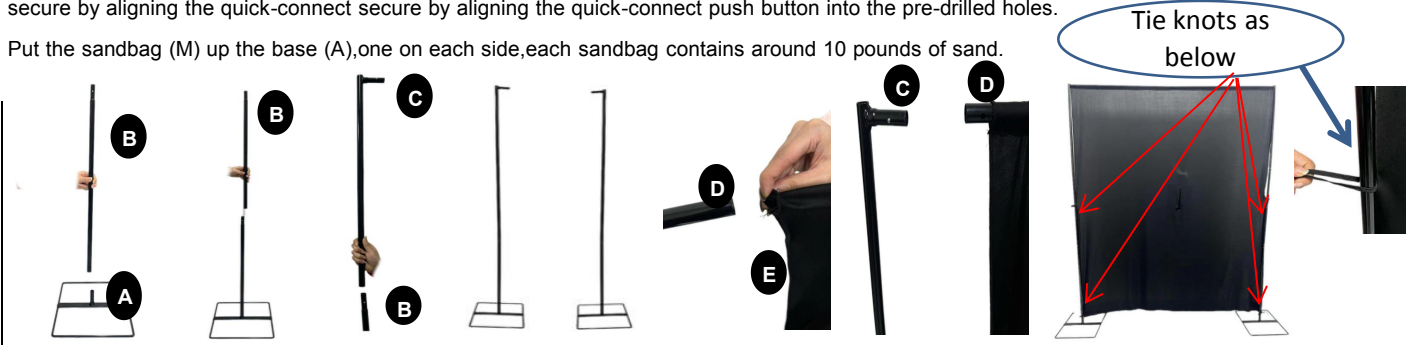

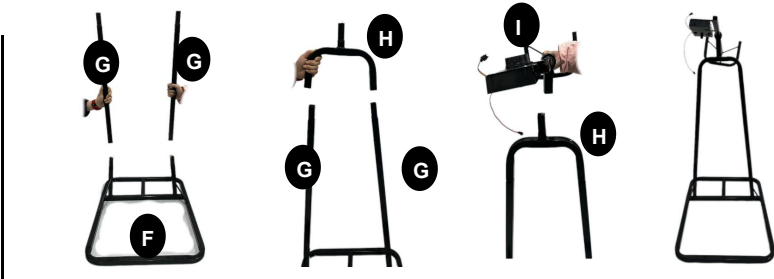
STEP 1:SETTING UP THE BACKDROP

Attach support pole(B)to the base (A) as shown and secure by aligning the quick-connect push button into the pre-drilled holes. Attach the other Support Pole (B) and (C) as shown and secure by aligning the quick-connect push button into the pre-drilled holes.Repeat the above as shown. Setting the 2 transverse poles (D) as shown and put them through the backdrop as shown,then attach them to the 2 support poles (C) as shown and secure by aligning the quick-connect secure by aligning the quick-connect push button into the pre-drilled holes. Put the sandbag (M) up the base (A),one on each side,each sandbag contains around 10 pounds of sand.



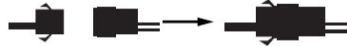
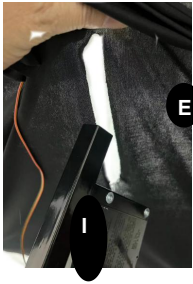
STEP 2:SETTING UP THE BASE AND SUPPORT POLES, AND ATTACHEING THE TORSO FRAME

Attach support poles(G)to the base (F) as shown and secure by aligning the quick-connect push button into the pre-drilled holes. Set the waist frame(G) to support poles D & E as shown. and secure by aligning the quick-connect push button into the pre-drilled holes. Attach the Torso Frame (I) to waist frame (G) as shown and secure by aligning the quick-connect push button into the pre-drilled holes.



STEP 3: ATTACHING THE HEAD

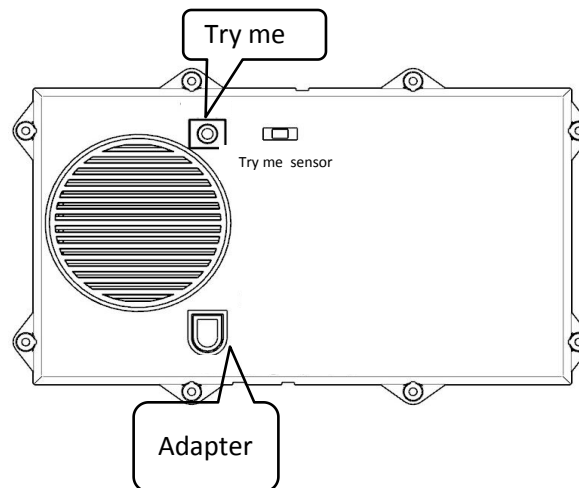
Put the torso frame (I) through the backdrop (E) as shown. And setting the head (J) as show and secure by aligning the quick-connect push button into the pre-drilled holes. Carefully connect connector jack wired from the function box to the head.

**FINISH****OPERATION INSTRUCTION**

Brick Thunder Dire Dragon's Head Animated Decoration has 2 operation settings which can be the main function control box on the torso frame.

TRY ME: This setting allows the item to only be activated when you push the try me button is activated.

Sensor: This setting included sound sensor, this setting allows the item to only be activated when the sensor is activated. the item will operate for one audio-cycle with sensor activation.
